# 8:30 a.m. 715.1 Building Your Coop's Culture: The Supervisor's Role - Andrea K. Schiller, Schiller Network

Overview: "Culture eats strategy for breakfast," is a famous quote by the late business management guru Peter Drucker. All great organizations have great cultures, and great cultures are designed intentionally, not left to chance. Organizational culture is defined as a system of shared assumptions, values and beliefs which governs how people behave in organizations. This course addresses the steps supervisors can take to help build a other, hold culture where employees trust each themselves others) accountable, focus their efforts on (and the co-op's goals and strive to continuously improve their processes.
