# **BYLAWS** of the SOUTH DAKOTA RURAL ELECTRIC MEMBER SERVICES ASSOCIATION Approved May 2014; Amended October 2018

#### ARTICLE I – NAME

**SECTION 1.** The name of this Organization shall be the South Dakota Rural Electric Member Services Association, hereinafter referred to as the Association.

#### ARTICLE II – OBJECTIVES

**SECTION 1.** The objective of the Association shall be to promote and advance all phases of the rural electric program and continually strive for the wise and efficient use of electric power. The Association shall provide a medium for exchange of facts, ideas and experiences that will provide for the betterment of the rural electrification program.

#### ARTICLE III – MEMBERSHIP

**SECTION 1.** Membership shall be open to all rural electric cooperatives. The Treasurer shall, at the beginning of January, send a dues notice as agreed upon by the membership, to all active members.

SECTION 2. Members shall consist of any personnel engaged in the rural electric program in South Dakota.

**SECTION 3.** Honorary memberships may be granted to those who are associated with the rural electric program or who have retired from a member rural electric cooperative. An honorary membership may be granted upon a unanimous vote of the officers of the Association. Honorary members are non-paying members and are not permitted to vote.

#### **ARTICLE IV – GOVERNING BODY**

**SECTION 1.** The governing body of the Association shall be known as the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall be comprised of four elected officers from the association membership. The officers elected by the Association shall be President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer.

#### ARTICLE V – OFFICERS

**SECTION 1.** A single officer will be elected annually during the Fall Association meeting for the position of Secretary. The acting secretary shall then move up to Vice President and the acting Vice President now becomes the President.

**SECTION 2.** The treasurer shall be elected from among the members of the association and shall serve a three year term. At the end of his/her term the treasurer shall be given the option of moving into the office of Secretary before an election is held for that position. At the end of his/her term the treasurer may also be nominated and elected to serve an additional three year term as treasurer. The office of treasurer will not be subject to term limits but will always be given first option to advance to the office of Secretary at the end of any given term prior to an election being held for the office of Secretary.

**SECTION 3.** Any active Association member is eligible to be an officer, with the exception of one officer from one cooperative at a time.

**SECTION 4.** The president shall preside at all business meetings and planning sessions and shall be the spokesman for the Association.

**SECTION 5.** If the president is unable to act, their duties shall be performed by the vice president. In the event neither the president nor the vice president can serve, the Board shall appoint a president pro-tempore.

SECTION 6. The secretary shall record the minutes of all meetings.

**SECTION 7**. The treasurer shall be responsible for all funds of the Association. The Association's accounts shall be audited at the close of each year, or as otherwise directed by the Board.

#### ARTICLE VI – BOARD OF DIRECTORS

#### The Board shall:

- a) Have the power to fill any vacancies occurring in its number;
- b) Appoint two members of the Association (one east and one west) for an undetermined period of time to assist in the planning and development of the Spring and Fall meetings.
- c) Appoint one representative from East River Electric Power Cooperative and one representative from Rushmore Electric Power Cooperative for an undetermined period of time to assist in the planning and development of the Spring and Fall meetings
- d) Recommend to the Association, action and/or interpretation of these Bylaws;
- e) Have responsibility of developing the Fall and Spring Member Services Conference;
- f) Provide general direction/guidance of the expenditure of funds;
- g) Perform such other duties as may hereinafter be approved by the Association.

#### **ARTICLE VII. ASSOCIATION**

**SECTION 1.** The Association is organized to carry out the purposes enumerated above and the standard purposes adopted by the members. It is organized exclusively as an exempt organization under Section 501 (c)(6) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

**SECTION 2.** The regulation of the internal affairs of this Association shall be conducted as set forth in its duly adopted bylaws. Initial bylaws shall be adopted by the board. Thereafter, the bylaws approved by the membership shall determine how they shall be revised.

**SECTION 3.** Upon dissolution, all remaining net assets shall, upon majority vote of the members, be distributed to a qualified non-profit entity with purposes similar to this Association.

**SECTION 4.** The Articles of Association may be amended from time to time by the members. These Articles of Association correctly set forth the intentions of the organizers and have been duly adopted herein.
